Icebreaker: What do you look forward to? In other words, what is one hope for your/other's future? May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (Rom. 15:13)

<u>Helplessness</u> doesn't equal <u>hopelessness</u> – "Be strong and take heart, all you who hope in the Lord." (Psalm 31:24) – are there any areas in life in which you tend to feel helpless? Do those same areas equate to a sense of hopelessness? If so, do you hand those areas over to God in prayer? What happens when you do?

One way our hope is strengthened is through the <u>certainty</u> of God's presence... do you tend to view God more "up there" or "around here?" How does that affect your life daily?

God has always been with His people...

- **He was with Moses** "I will be with you. And this will be the sign to you, that it is I who have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you will worship God on this mountain." **(Exod. 3:12)**
- He was with David "I have been with you wherever you have gone... I will make your name great, like the names of the greatest men of the earth." (2 Sam. 7:9)

• <u>Leads</u> us through <u>life</u> — "He calls His own sheep by name and leads them out. When He has brought out all His own, He goes on ahead of them, and His sheep follow Him because they know His voice. But they will never follow a stranger; in fact, they will run away from him because they do not recognize a strangers voice...I am the good shepherd." (John 10:3b-5, 11)

• <u>Pastors</u> us through <u>pain</u> — "I myself will tend my sheep and have them lie down, declares the Sovereign LORD. I will search for the lost and bring back the strays. I will build up the injured and strengthen the weak..." (Ezek. 34:15-16)

Do you trust His heart?

• Secured our <u>salvation</u> – "I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me – just as the Father knows me and I know the Father – and I lay down my life for the sheep." (John 10:14-15)
