Discipleship Principle: Multiply - Empower disciples to make other disciples

Scripture Focus: 2 Timothy 2:2

Discussion Opener

Proximity and Vulnerability. How did it go this week for you in identifying someone to bring into proximity and to be vulnerable with?

Discussion Questions

1. Read 2 Timothy 2:2 outloud as a group. If you want to be a multiplier, you have to be someone who empowers others. Timothy heard, saw, and imitated Paul as Paul followed Jesus. Now, Paul is encouraging Timothy to do the same with others. This moment is when you start to see multiplication take place. What is the greatest challenge when it comes to empowering other people? How can we begin to empower others in our life to make disciples?
2. Discuss the 4 Principles for Movement Multiplication. What is the greatest challenge you face? Take time and apply these practically to our life:
 - Call Up (2 Tim. 1:6)
 - Call Out (2 Tim. 1:7-8a)
 - Circle Up (2 Tim. 4:9, 11)
 - Build Up (Rom. 16:3, 6-7, 12a)

Practice/Discipline For the Week: Encourage and Empower. If there is someone you in a discipleship relationship with, meet with them and ask specific questions like:

- Who in your life are you trying to reach for Jesus?
- How are you doing when it comes to being in proximity and vulnerable with those around you?
- How are you doing when it comes to “Exposing” people to the love and grace of Jesus in your life?
