Main Point: We should bing peace to the world

Discussion Opener

Share a story about a time you made peace with someone.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Read the lyrics of "I Heard the Bells on Christmas Day" outloud.
- 2. The Author of the song, Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, heard the Christmas bells ringing in Cambridge and the singing of "peace on earth", but he observed the world of injustice and violence that seemed to mock the truthfulness of this optimistic outlook. The song is written in the middle of the American Civil War. Have you ever looked around at all of the brokeness in our world and felt discouraged? What is it you see that discourages you most?
- 3. When it comes to peace, what are the greatest challenges we face to seeing that come to: our life, our families, our workplaces, our world, etc.
- 4. There Is Hope: The song eventually leads to a settledness of confident hope even in the midst of bleak despair as he recounts to himself that God is alive and righteousness shall prevail. However you asnwered in the previous two questions, there is hope for every situation. Jesus can and has brought peace. How does the hope and peace of Jesus encourage you in your life? In what ways do we need to shift our perspective in light of this hope?
