INTRO QUESTION

Have you ever backed down from something—not because it was wrong—but because it seemed way bigger than you?

DIGGING INTO THE TEXT - 1 SAMUEL 17:1-30

What do we learn from the active role of the Philistines ("gathered their forces") versus the passive role of Saul and the Israelites ("assembled")?

How does this ongoing conflict shape our understanding of Saul's leadership and the stakes of this moment?

Why is the narrator so detailed in describing Goliath's size and armor? What effect is that intended to have on the reader—and on Israel?

How does Goliath's challenge in v.8 echo the language of 12:13 ("the king you have chosen")? What is the irony here?

Discuss the contrast between David's eagerness at the front lines (v.22) with Saul hiding among the supplies in 10:22.

David's first recorded words are theologically charged. How does his perspective differ from the rest of Israel?

In what ways do David's words echo Hannah's prayer in 2:10 and Jonathan's declaration in 14:6? What does that say about the kind of faith God honors? How does the reaction of David's brothers (vv.28–30) parallel the reaction Jesus received from His own family in Mark 3:20–21?
