21 DAY PRAYER

ISAIAH 54:1-3

“Sing, O childless woman, you who have never given birth! Break into loud and joyful song, O Jerusalem, you who have never been in labor. For the desolate woman now has more children than the woman who lives with her husband,” says the Lord.

Enlarge the place of your tent and let them stretch out the curtains of your dwellings; Do not spare; Lengthen your cords and strengthen your stakes. For you shall expand to the right and to the left, and your descendants will inherit the nations, and make the desolate cities inhabited.”

PASTOR'S NOTE

As we step into a new season filled with new opportunities, I couldn't be more excited about what God is doing in and through our Liberty Church family. This 21-day devotional and prayer guide is designed to help us unite our hearts, stretch our faith, and trust God in fresh, powerful ways.

DAY FIVE

Isaiah 54:3 NKJV

“For you shall expand to the right and to the left, and your descendants will inherit the nations, and make the desolate cities inhabited.”

Heavenly Father, we thank You that, as we expand to the right and to the left, Your will is being done, on earth as it is in heaven! As we take possession of the land and expand our borders, Your kingdom increases. Nation upon nation shall be drawn to You as we spread the good news of the gospel of Jesus. Even our children's children and beyond will inherit the nations to restore and inhabit the broken-down cities, who have lost faith and who have lost hope.

DAY SIX

1 Chronicles 4:10 NKJV

“And Jabez called on the God of Israel saying, “Oh, that You would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that Your hand would be with me, and that You would keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain!” So God granted him what he requested.”

DAY EIGHT

2 Corinthians 9:10,11 NASB

“Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness; you will be enriched in everything for all liberality, which through us is producing thanksgiving to God.”

Father, we thank You for being a good Father and forever supplying seed to Your children; not only supplying the seed but multiplying it as well. DAY NINE

2 Cor. 9:6,7 NASB

“Remember this—a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop. You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don’t give reluctantly or in response to pressure. For God loves a person who gives cheerfully.”

Father, Thank You for allowing us to take part in planting seeds. As we plant the seeds, Your kingdom increases!

Father, forgive us when we’ve given miserly, reluctantly, or begrudgingly, for we know that all we have comes from You. Make us conduits and rivers of Your many blessings! DAY TEN

Proverbs 11:25 NKJV

“The generous soul will be made rich, and he who waters will also be watered himself.”

May we “water” others as Your living water flows through us. May we freely give in all things as we have freely received. In Jesus' name. Amen

DAY ELEVEN

Malachi 3:10,11 NLT

“Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in my Temple. If you do,” says the LORD of Heaven’s Armies, “I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won’t have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test! And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, so that he will not destroy the fruit of your ground, nor shall the vine fail to bear fruit for you in the field,” says the LORD of hosts;

Father, thank You for Your promise that if we bring our tithes into the storehouse, there will be food in Your house; and that You will open for us the windows of heaven and pour out for us such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it.

Father, thank You, that it is Your will to enlarge Liberty Church's territory. Give us the grace to be faithful in giving our tithes and offerings so that the church will have the resources that it needs to do the work that You have called us to do.

Jesus called his disciples to him and said, “I tell you the truth, this poor widow has given more than all the others who are making contributions. For they gave a tiny part of their surplus, but she, poor as she is, has given everything she had to live on.”

Heavenly Father, help us to have a heart of a giver like this poor widow, giving not out of her wealth but giving out of her love and faith in You. Trusting You with every penny she had. DAY FIFTEEN

Matthew 7:11 NLT

“If you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give good gifts to those who ask him.”

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need."

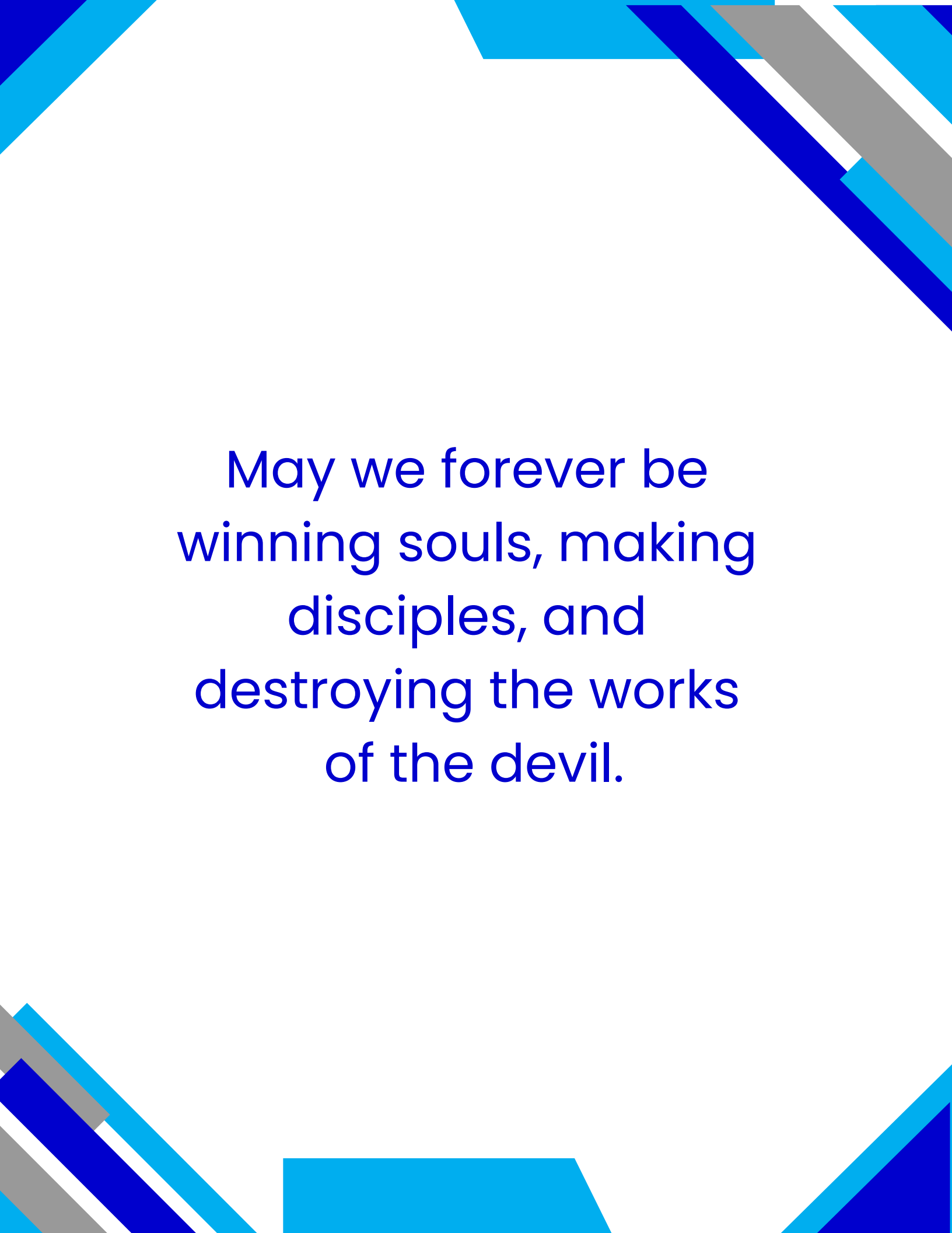
