Message Theme

Modern UFOs And End Times Deception

Prayer Focus

“Heavenly Father, thank You for being my source of truth in a world filled with confusion and deception. Give me discernment through Your Word, courage to stand firm in my faith, and wisdom to recognize Your voice above all others. Keep my heart focused on Jesus and help me to walk faithfully with You each day. Fill me with Your Holy Spirit, strengthen me when I am weak, and give me peace as I trust in Your promises. In Jesus' name, Amen.”

Key Truths

In Genesis, giants are mentioned as the result of humanity's DNA being corrupted. The fallen angels believed that if they could contaminate the human race, then the prophesied Seed of the woman would never come. But Noah and his family remained untouched—set apart in their generation—and were therefore spared from the Flood, preserving the lineage through which Jesus would eventually come.

Are we alone in the universe? The Bible speaks of angels, cherubim, seraphim, Nephilim, and other spiritual beings. From a biblical perspective, we are clearly not alone.

The first time Satan appears in Scripture, he does not appear in his original form but as a serpent. In the same way, UFO sightings may be manifestations of the demonic. When a demonic entity wants to be seen, it can present itself in whatever form best fits the technological understanding of the age. The spiritual realm is usually invisible, but it can become visible at times.

Many modern UFO sightings appear to defy the known laws of physics, further suggesting that they are not of this world and may be behaving in a manner consistent with the demonic realm. This phenomenon could be part of the strong delusion that Scripture says will come in the last days, deceiving many and drawing them away from the truth.

But believers do not need to live in fear. Jesus Christ has already defeated Satan through His death and resurrection, and those who belong to Him are secure in His hands. No deception, no spiritual power, and no scheme of the enemy can separate us from the love of God in Christ. As the days grow darker, our focus

should not be on fear of deception but on drawing closer to the Lord, remaining grounded in His Word, and walking in the power of the Holy Spirit.

Declarations

Life is released when your words are in agreement with God. Intentionally speaking life and biblical truth out loud is extremely powerful. In fact, you have that very life in the power of your tongue. These words below, when spoken out loud, will cause an acceleration of the reality of God's words in your life. We encourage you to speak the following with an expectancy to renew your mind and see God's fullness.

- "The Holy Spirit guides me into all truth and gives me discernment."
- "Fear, confusion, and deception have no hold over me."
- "My mind is renewed by the Word of God."
- "I have authority in Christ over all the power of the enemy."
- "God is preserving me, and my family, in this generation."
- "My eyes are fixed on Jesus and not on the distractions of this world."

Practical Application

Our next step is simple: stay rooted in God's Word and keep your eyes on Jesus. As deception increases, believers must grow in discernment through prayer, Scripture, and obedience to the Holy Spirit. Rather than becoming consumed with signs and mysteries, focus on knowing Christ more deeply.

Take time today to :

1. Examine your walk with God
 - Spend time talking with and listening to Him.
2. Commit yourself to His truth
 - Jesus is the Truth. When He shows you something, let it change the way you think, which will change the way you live.

3. Encourage others to do the same

- Yes, use words, but let the light that is in you shine so that people see the evidence of the Truth at work in your life. This lights up and changes the world.

Just as God preserved Noah in his generation, He is faithful to preserve those who trust in Him.
