Highlighted Scripture

Proverbs 3:5–6 (ESV)

**Trust in the Lord with all your heart,
and do not lean on your own understanding.
In all your ways acknowledge him,
and he will make straight your paths.**

Discussion Questions

- 1. Shane reminded us that obedience begins with trust, not confidence. How does Proverbs 3:5–6 reinforce that truth?**
- 2. Why is it so tempting to lean on our own understanding instead of fully trusting God's direction?**
- 3. The message emphasized that God's calling is ultimately for His glory, not ours. How does acknowledging God "in all your ways" help keep the focus on Him?**
- 4. Fear asks for certainty before moving forward, but faith takes the next step with God. Where might God be asking you to trust Him without seeing the full path?**
- 5. How does trusting God with your plans free you from pressure, pride, or fear of failure?**

Reflection Challenge

This week, intentionally practice trusting God with the next step, not the whole journey.

Ask yourself daily:

- **Am I leaning on my understanding or trusting God's wisdom?**
- **Have I acknowledged God in today's decisions?**
- **Where can I surrender control and walk in obedience?**
