Highlighted Scripture

Luke 24:13–35 (NLT)

“As they talked and discussed these things, Jesus himself suddenly came and began walking with them. But God kept them from recognizing him... Then their eyes were opened and they recognized him—and at that moment he disappeared!”

Discussion Questions

- 1. Why do you think Jesus chose to hide His identity from the two men on the road?**
- 2. Can you think of a time when you later realized Jesus had been walking with you through something difficult?**
- 3. What helps open your spiritual eyes to recognize His presence in your life?**
- 4. How can we help others “see” Jesus through the way we live and serve?**
- 5. What does it mean for your heart to “burn within you” when Jesus speaks through Scripture?**

Reflection Challenge

This week, slow down and pay attention to the subtle ways Jesus walks beside you.

Notice moments of peace, unexpected kindness, or guidance that remind you He's there.

Each day, pause to ask:

"Lord, help me recognize You in my journey today."

Write down one moment where you felt His presence—and thank Him for walking with you, even when you didn't see Him right away.

Prayer

Lord Jesus, thank You for walking beside us even when we don't recognize You. Open our eyes, ears, hearts, and minds so we may see You in our daily lives. Help us to listen for Your voice and to learn the lessons You place before us. When we are blind or distracted, remind us that You are near—faithfully guiding and loving us. May our hearts burn within us as we walk with You each day. In Your holy name we pray, Amen.
