Highlighted Scripture

- **Matthew 5:14–16**

Jesus calls His followers to be the light of the world, living in such a way that others see their good works and glorify the Father in heaven.

- **2 Corinthians 5:17**

Those who belong to Christ are new creations. Their transformed lives become a testimony to God's saving grace.

- **Colossians 3:17**

Believers are instructed to do everything—in word and deed—in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God through Him.

Discussion Questions

- **Tony says we often influence people without realizing it. Why do you think our everyday actions can have such a lasting impact?**

- **Can you remember someone whose quiet example strengthened your faith more than their words?**
- **How can ordinary acts of kindness, patience, or self-control point people toward Christ?**
- **Why is consistency in our daily walk with God just as important as what we say about our faith?**
- **What opportunities has God placed before you this week to encourage someone simply by the way you live?**

Reflection Challenge

Intentionally live with the awareness that others are watching how you represent Christ.

Ask yourself:

- **Does my daily life reflect the peace and love of Christ?**
- **How do I respond when people test my patience or disappoint me?**
- **What simple act of encouragement could God use through me today?**

Try this:

- **Offer a genuine word of encouragement to someone who may need hope.**
- **Practice responding to frustration with grace rather than anger.**
- **Pray each morning that your words, actions, and attitude would point others to Jesus.**

- **Thank God for the opportunities He gives you to quietly influence those around you.**

Remember

- **God often uses ordinary acts of faithfulness to accomplish extraordinary purposes.**
- **Your life may be encouraging people in ways you cannot yet see.**
- **Actions often reinforce the message of the Gospel.**
- **Every believer has a calling to represent Christ each day.**
- **Faithfully living for Christ can leave an eternal impact on others.**
