## Highlighted Scripture

## Discussion Questions

- 1. What does “It is finished” mean to you personally?**
- 2. Which of the four meanings of tetelestai—servant, priest, artist, or merchant—stood out to you most, and why?**
- 3. How does understanding the depth of Jesus’ words change the way you view the cross?**
- 4. Do you sometimes struggle to accept that your “debt is paid in full”? Why or why not?**
- 5. How can you live each day in gratitude for the finished work of Christ?**

## Reflection Challenge

**Spend time this week meditating on the words “It is finished.”**

**Write down one area of your life where you’ve been carrying guilt, shame, or a sense of debt—and surrender it at the foot of the cross.**

**Remind yourself daily:**

**“Jesus has already paid it in full.”**

**Let that truth free you to walk in peace, gratitude, and victory.**
