Highlighted Scripture

Discussion Questions

- 3. What are some small, practical ways you can begin sharing your story of faith with others?**
- 4. How has the Holy Spirit guided you in moments when you stepped out in faith?**

5. Rob shared how his wife helped him understand personal relationship with Christ—who has helped guide you spiritually?

Reflection Challenge

Pray specifically for one opportunity to share a small piece of your faith story with someone—no pressure, no performance, just openness to the Holy Spirit's prompting.

Let God guide the conversation rather than forcing it. Trust that He will give you the words, the timing, and the courage.

And as we move through this Thanksgiving season, remember to thank God for your story, even the difficult parts—because He uses all of it to draw others closer to Christ.
