The Blood of Jesus Upon Us

Speaker: Tony Orihuela

Highlighted Scripture

Matthew 27:24–25

Tony references the moment when Pontius Pilate washed his hands before the crowd and the people responded, "Let his blood be on us and on our children."

Matthew 27:21–23

Tony references Pilate offering the crowd a choice between Jesus and Barabbas, and the crowd repeatedly demanding the release of Barabbas.

Discussion Questions

- **Why do you think the crowd chose Barabbas instead of Jesus?**
- **How does Tony reinterpret the phrase "Let his blood be upon us and our children"?**
- **What does the blood of Jesus represent for believers today?**

- **Why is it important to remember what Christ accomplished through His sacrifice?**
- **How can remembering Christ's sacrifice strengthen your faith during difficult seasons?**

Reflection Challenge

This week, spend time reflecting on what Jesus accomplished through His death and resurrection.

Ask yourself:

- **Do I regularly remember the price Jesus paid for my salvation?**
- **How has Christ's sacrifice changed my life?**
- **Am I sharing with others what God has done for me?**

Try this:

- **Spend time thanking God specifically for the gift of salvation.**
- **Write down ways God has rescued, protected, or guided you throughout your life.**
- **Share a testimony with someone about what Christ has done for you.**
- **Pray for your children, family, and future generations to know and follow Jesus.**

Remember

- **Jesus willingly shed His blood for the forgiveness of sins.**

- **Salvation is possible because of Christ's sacrifice.**
- **Remembering God's work strengthens our faith.**
- **Christ's death and resurrection continue to impact believers today.**
- **The Gospel is worth sharing with future generations.**
