No Scripture Included for This Study — By Speaker's Instruction

The speaker explicitly chose not to include any scripture references. Why?

Because she wanted each listener to look up their own scripture regarding uniqueness, identity, spiritual gifts, and God's design for their life. She encouraged everyone to:

- Search the Bible themselves
- Read the entire chapter around any verse they find
- Allow the Holy Spirit to personally guide the discovery

This study is intentionally built around your own exploration of God's Word.

Discussion Questions

- 1. What are the expectations or pressures—spoken or unspoken—that have made you feel like you need to "perform" or look a certain way to be a "real Christian"?
- 2. In what ways have insecurity, guilt, or comparison hindered your walk with Christ?
- 3. What does it mean to you personally that God created you uniquely with a one-of-a-kind personality, story, and gifting?

- 4. How does viewing prayer as a conversation with your Father (rather than a performance) change your approach to spending time with God?
- 5. In what areas is God inviting you to stop trying to fit in—and instead embrace who He created you to be?

Reflection Challenge

This week, take time to explore what God says about your identity. Since no specific scriptures were provided, follow the speaker's instruction:

- Pick one area where you feel insecure, unseen, or "not enough."
- Look up scriptures related to that topic (identity, uniqueness, gifts, God's love, etc.).
- Read not only the verse but the entire chapter around it.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to show you how your uniqueness is designed for a purpose.

And remember:

Don't try to be who you think others expect — be who God handcrafted you to be.

Help me understand who I am in You — uniquely made, deeply loved, and created with purpose.

Teach me to walk in confidence, not comparison.

Remove the expectations that others have placed on me, and free me from the pressures that keep me from a genuine walk with You.
