🐆 Highlighted Scriptures

John 2:7-10 (NIV)

"Jesus said to the servants, 'Fill the jars with water'; so they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, 'Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet.' They did so, and the master of the banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine. He did not realize where it had come from, though the servants who had drawn the water knew. Then he called the bridegroom aside and said, 'Everyone brings out the choice wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved the best till now."

John 10:10 (NIV)

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full."

Discussion Questions

- 1. Why do you think Mary was so confident that Jesus could do something about the wine running out?
- 2. What does this story teach us about God's nature of abundance?
- 3. Have you ever felt like "plain water" ordinary or unnoticed? How can you invite Jesus to transform you?

4. How does the promise of John 10:10 encourage you to live life "to the full" in Christ?

Reflection Challenge

- Reflect on an area of your life where you feel "ordinary" and ask God to transform it for His glory.
- Memorize John 2:10 as a reminder that God's best is never behind you - He saves the best for last.
- Share encouragement with someone who may feel overlooked, reminding them of their value in Christ.

Prayer Prompt

"Lord Jesus, thank You that You see me even when I feel like plain water. Thank You that You came to give life, and life more abundantly. Transform my heart and fill me with Your Spirit so that my life may reflect Your goodness and glory. Help me to trust that You can make me into something far more valuable than I could ever be on my own. In Your name I pray, Amen."
