Children of God Through Faith

Highlighted Scripture

- **Galatians 3:24–29**

Paul explains that the Law served as a guardian until Christ came. Through faith in Jesus, believers are made right with God, become His children, are united in Christ, and receive the promises given to Abraham as heirs of God.

Discussion Questions

- **According to Galatians 3, what changed when Christ came that made the Law no longer our guardian?**
- **Randy reminds us that we are all children of God through faith in Christ. How should that truth shape the way we see ourselves and other believers?**
- **Paul says there is "neither Jew nor Gentile, slave nor free, male nor female." What does this teach about our unity in Christ?**

- **What does it mean to be an heir to God's promises?**
- **Randy encourages us to pass our faith on to future generations. What are some practical ways we can do that within our families and communities?**

Reflection Challenge

This week, live as someone who belongs to God's family.

Ask yourself:

- **Do I truly believe my identity is found in Christ rather than in my background, achievements, or failures?**
- **Am I treating other believers as brothers and sisters in Christ?**
- **How can I intentionally pass my faith on to someone else this week?**

Try this:

- **Read Galatians 3:24–29 and thank God for adopting you into His family through faith in Jesus.**
- **Encourage another believer by reminding them of their identity in Christ.**
- **Share a lesson God has taught you with a family member, friend, or younger believer.**
- **Pray for the next generation to know and faithfully follow Christ.**

Remember

- **Salvation comes through faith in Jesus Christ, not through keeping the Law.**
- **Every believer is a child of God through faith.**
- **Our identity in Christ unites us with believers from every background.**
- **As God's children, we are heirs of His promises.**
- **We are called to faithfully pass our faith on to the next generation.**
