Highlighted Scripture

- 4. In what ways can you show God’s love through your actions this week?**
- 5. What are some small habits or attitudes (like Truly mentioned) that you can work on to reflect Christ better?**

- Be intentional with your words today — choose to speak life and encouragement.**
- Reflect on how your daily actions can quietly testify of your faith to others.**
- Ask God to help you walk in kindness and humility, showing His character in all you do.**
- Remember that someone may be drawn to Christ simply by watching how you live.**
