## Highlighted Scripture

**Matthew 28:19–20 (NKJV)**

**Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.**

**Romans 10:14–15 (NKJV)**

**How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed?  
And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard?  
And how shall they hear without a preacher?**

## Discussion Questions

- 1. The speaker shared the number 40,170,000 youth in America who are not saved. How does hearing that number affect the way you view the mission of sharing the gospel?**
- 2. Why do you think God places such an emphasis on reaching one person at a time rather than overwhelming us with the whole picture?**
- 3. The speaker encouraged continued prayer even when loved ones seem resistant. What makes perseverance in prayer so difficult — and so important?**
- 4. Who is the “one” person God may be placing on your heart right now — a family member, neighbor, or someone you haven’t spoken to in**

**5. What does it practically look like for you to be the hands, feet, and voice of Jesus in your daily life?**

## **Reflection Challenge**

**This week, intentionally focus on one person.**

**Ask yourself:**

- **Who am I praying for by name?**
- **Am I trusting God with the outcome, even when I don't see change yet?**
- **Am I willing to be used — through prayer, conversation, or example?**
