Faithfulness in the Ordinary

Highlighted Scripture

- **Colossians 3:23–24**

Whatever believers do, they are to work wholeheartedly as serving the Lord, knowing that their ultimate reward comes from Him.

- **Luke 16:10**

Jesus teaches that those who are faithful in small things can also be trusted with greater responsibilities.

- **Zechariah 4:10**

God warns His people not to despise small beginnings, reminding them that He delights in faithful obedience even when it seems insignificant.

Discussion Questions

- **Shane suggests that we often wait for "big moments" to serve God. Why do you think we overlook the ordinary opportunities He gives us each day?**

- **How did Jesus model faithfulness through everyday interactions during His earthly ministry?**
- **What are some ordinary moments in your daily routine where you can intentionally reflect Christ?**
- **Why is consistency in small acts of obedience often more difficult than waiting for one significant opportunity?**
- **How can viewing your daily responsibilities as opportunities to serve God change your perspective?**

Reflection Challenge

This week, look for God in the ordinary moments of your day.

Ask yourself:

- **Am I waiting for a bigger opportunity when God has already placed opportunities in front of me?**
- **How can I honor Christ in my work, my home, and my everyday conversations?**
- **Who around me needs a simple act of kindness, encouragement, or prayer today?**

Try this:

- **Intentionally encourage one person each day this week.**
- **Pray before beginning your daily work, asking God to use you wherever He has placed you.**
- **Look for one ordinary moment each day where you can demonstrate Christ's love through your actions.**

- **At the end of each day, reflect on one opportunity God gave you to be faithful.**

Remember

- **God often accomplishes His greatest work through ordinary acts of faithfulness.**
- **Small moments of obedience matter in God's kingdom.**
- **Every conversation, every act of kindness, and every faithful decision can point someone toward Christ.**
- **Faithfulness today prepares us for whatever God has planned tomorrow.**
- **We don't have to wait for extraordinary opportunities to faithfully serve God.**
