Highlighted Scripture

1 Corinthians 6:19–20

Believers were bought at a price and are called to honor God with their lives because they belong to Him.

Proverbs 13:20

Walking closely with wise people leads to wisdom, while unhealthy influences can lead people astray.

Matthew 5:14–16

Jesus calls believers to shine as light in the world so others may see God reflected through their lives.

Romans 12:1–2

- **In what practical ways can believers reflect Christ in everyday life?**

Reflection Challenge

Focus on allowing God to shape your heart, thoughts, and daily actions.

Ask yourself:

- **Am I seeing myself through God's truth or through the world's opinions?**
- **What influences in my life are helping—or hurting—my walk with God?**
- **How can I intentionally reflect Christ in my home, workplace, or community?**

Try this:

- **Spend time daily praying for God to transform your thinking**
- **Evaluate one influence in your life that may need healthier boundaries**

- **Look for one opportunity each day to reflect Christ through kindness, encouragement, or integrity**

- **Your identity and value come from God**
- **The people and influences around you matter spiritually**
- **Christians are called to carry Christ's light into everyday life**
- **Spiritual renewal begins personally before it spreads outwardly**
- **God desires transformation from the inside out**
