Highlighted Scripture

1 Chronicles 16:34

Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His love endures forever.

1 Thessalonians 5:18

Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Colossians 3:15

Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.

Colossians 3:17

And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

Colossians 4:2

Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful.

Discussion Questions

1. What are some small, everyday blessings that you often overlook?

- 2. How can practicing gratitude change your perspective on challenges?
- 3. What does it mean to give thanks in all circumstances, not just for them?

### Reflection Challenge

Take time this week to turn your daily routine into moments of thanksgiving.

When something goes right—or even when it doesn't—pause and say, "Thank You, Lord."

Keep a running list of these moments throughout the week and watch how it changes your outlook. Gratitude turns the ordinary into worship.
