Luke 2:41–52 (NIV)

"Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's house?" (v.49)

Highlighted Scriptures

- **Luke 2:49 (NIV): "Why were you searching for me?" he asked. "Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's house?"**
- **Luke 2:52 (NIV): "And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man."**
- **Matthew 9:37 (NIV): "Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few.'"**
