## **Remembering God's Faithfulness**

### **Highlighted Scripture**

- **Exodus**

**Julie reflects on how God delivered the Israelites from Egypt, brought them through the plagues and the Exodus, and continually provided for them despite their tendency to forget His faithfulness.**

- **Psalms 145**

**David's psalm of praise emphasizing God's greatness, faithfulness, compassion, provision, and enduring kingdom. This is the primary Scripture passage read and discussed throughout the devotional.**

### **Discussion Questions**

- **Why do people often forget God's past faithfulness when facing new challenges?**
- **What similarities do you see between the Israelites' struggles and our own lives today?**

- **How can remembering God's past provision strengthen your faith during difficult seasons?**
- **Why is it important to tell future generations about God's goodness and faithfulness?**
- **Which truth from Psalm 145 stood out to you most and why?**

### **Reflection Challenge**

**Spend time remembering how God has worked in your life.**

**Ask yourself:**

- **What situations has God already brought me through?**
- **Have I been focusing more on my current problems than on God's faithfulness?**
- **How can I better praise God for what He has already done?**

**Try this:**

- **Write down three ways God has provided for you in the past year.**
- **Read Psalm 145 and reflect on God's character.**
- **Share a testimony of God's faithfulness with someone this week.**
- **Spend time thanking God instead of only bringing Him requests.**

**Remember**

- **God's faithfulness does not change.**

- **Remembering God's past provision builds present trust.**
- **Praise helps keep our focus on God rather than our circumstances.**
- **God provides according to His perfect timing.**
- **Future generations need to hear about God's goodness and faithfulness.**
