Highlighted Scriptures

Psalm 37:23–24 (NIV)

“The Lord makes firm the steps of the one who delights in him; though he may stumble, he will not fall, for the Lord upholds him with his hand.”

Psalm 34:11–14 (NIV)

“Come, my children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the Lord. Whoever of you loves life and desires to see many good days, keep your tongue from evil and your lips from telling lies. Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.”

Discussion Questions

- 1. What does it mean to you that God “makes firm your steps” even when you stumble?**
- 2. How do these verses encourage you when you reflect on your own past mistakes or challenges?**
- 3. In what areas of your life do you need to make more intentional choices to “seek peace and pursue it”?**
- 4. How can your faith and walk with God be a source of encouragement for others, as Julie’s faith is for her grandson?**

Reflection Challenge

This week:

- **Reflect on moments in your life when you stumbled but God upheld you. Write them down as reminders of His faithfulness.**
- **Make a conscious effort to choose truth, kindness, and peace in your words and actions.**
- **Pray daily for someone in your life who is struggling, asking God to guide their steps and strengthen their faith.**
- **Remind yourself that your journey with God is not about perfection, but about trust in His hand holding you firm.**
