Galatians 6:2 (NIV)

Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.

John 13:14 (NIV)

Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet.

Romans 14:13 (NIV)

Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in the way of a brother or sister.

Galatians 5:13 (NIV)

You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.

Discussion Questions

- 3. Julie said, "I don't always see people the way Jesus sees people." How can you begin to change that perspective?
- 4. What does loving one another really require from us—beyond words?
- 5. What's one "One Another" verse you want to intentionally live out this week?

Reflection Challenge

- Start a Bible Plan: Look up the full list of the 59 "One Another" verses and print them out. Highlight a few you want to focus on this month.
- Love in Action: Choose one person to show intentional love to today through action—help, prayer, encouragement, or service.
- Evaluate Yourself Honestly: Do your words, actions, and thoughts align with the love Jesus modeled? Journal your honest reflection.
- Pray for a Heart Like His: Ask God to help you see others as He sees them—lovingly, graciously, and without judgment.
