Highlighted Scripture

Ecclesiastes 3:11

God makes everything fitting and beautiful in the right time. Even when we cannot fully understand what He is doing, He is still working with purpose from beginning to end.

Discussion Questions

- **What does it mean to have a “ready” heart instead of a “perfect” life?**
- **Why is it difficult to trust God when we cannot clearly see what He is doing?**
- **How have you experienced spiritual growth that was only noticeable in hindsight?**
- **In what ways has community helped strengthen your faith?**
- **What are some signs that God may be working in your life even if it feels slow?**

Reflection Challenge

Focus on recognizing what God is already doing in your life.

Ask yourself:

- **Am I overlooking small ways God is working because I'm expecting something bigger?**
- **Do I trust God's timing, or do I get discouraged when things feel slow?**
- **Am I staying connected to the people God has placed in my life?**

Try this:

- **Take time each day to reflect on one way God showed up, even if it was small**
- **Write down an area where you've seen growth over the past year**
- **Reach out to someone in your community and stay connected**

Remember

- **God is always working, even when you don't see it**
- **Growth is often slow, but it is always meaningful**
- **God's timing is intentional, not accidental**
- **Community is part of how God strengthens and shapes you**
