Discussion Questions

- 1. This passage calls believers to live in a way that leaves no room for accusation. Why do our everyday actions matter so much in our witness?**
- 2. Julie shares how jury duty and a difficult moving situation tested her response. Why are ordinary, stressful moments often the clearest reflection of our faith?**
- 3. What does it look like to respond with kindness and integrity when something does not go your way?**
- 4. The speaker asks, “What kind of example am I being?” Why is this an important question to regularly ask ourselves?**
- 5. How can living with integrity and dignity help others see God more clearly through us?**
