Highlighted Scripture

Romans 8:31-39 (ESV)

"What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? As it is written, 'For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered.' No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord."

 John 3:16 (ESV) – "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."

Discussion Questions

- 1. Do you struggle to realize the depth of God's love & commitment to you?
- 2. How have your feelings been in problem in your life before Christ?
- 3. How have they continued to be a problem in your walk with Him?
- 4. How does focusing on the truth (facts) of God's Word help you in dealing with these difficulties?

Devotional Homework

- This week, identify one area where your feelings conflict with God's Word. Write down a Scripture that declares the truth to replace that feeling.
- Meditate on Romans 8:38-39 to remind yourself that nothing can separate you from God's love.
- Share John 3:16 with someone who may be doubting God's love this week.

Lord, imprint the truth of Your love on our hearts and minds. Help us not to be led astray by our feelings but to rest in the facts of who You are and what You've done.
