Psalm 119:105 (KJV) "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path."

🧠 Summary

Carlos reflects on the simple yet profound truth found in Psalm 119:105, emphasizing how God's Word serves as a guide—not always showing the full road ahead, but illuminating each step just when it's needed. He shares how his natural tendency toward quick action and impatience has sometimes caused him to rush ahead of God's guidance, resulting in setbacks or frustration.

Instead, this devotional encourages believers to slow down and trust God's timing. When we rely on the light of His Word—step by step—we develop patience, deepen our faith, and live with greater purpose. God may only reveal the next step, not the whole journey, but that is where trust is built.

💬 Discussion Questions

• How has Psalm 119:105 spoken to you in seasons of uncertainty?

- What areas of your life are you tempted to "run ahead" instead of waiting on God's timing?
- Why do you think God sometimes only reveals one step at a time instead of the full path?
- How do trust, faith, and confidence grow when we choose to follow God slowly and deliberately?
- What spiritual practices can help you better wait on God and listen for His next direction?
