Highlighted Scripture

- **Ephesians 2:10**

"We are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works." Shane reminds us that God is still shaping and growing His people according to His purpose.

- **2 Corinthians 5:17**

Those who belong to Christ are new creations. The old life has passed away, and a new life has begun.

- **1 John 3:1**

John marvels at the Father's great love, declaring that believers are called children of God—and that is who they truly are.

Discussion Questions

- **Shane says, "Our identity changes everything." Why is understanding our identity in Christ so foundational to the Christian life?**

- **What are some false identities people often accept from the world instead of believing what God says about them?**
- **Shane contrasts earning God's love with living from God's love. What is the difference?**
- **How does knowing you are God's workmanship change the way you approach spiritual growth?**
- **Which truth about your identity in Christ do you most need to remember this week?**

Reflection Challenge

Intentionally replace false labels with God's truth.

Ask yourself:

- **Am I allowing my past, my failures, or other people's opinions to define me?**
- **What does God say about who I am in Christ?**
- **How would my decisions change if I truly believed I am loved, forgiven, and being transformed by God?**

Try this:

- **Read Ephesians 2:10 each morning and thank God that He is still at work in your life.**
- **Whenever a negative thought about your identity arises, replace it with a truth from Scripture.**
- **Write down three biblical truths about who you are in Christ and revisit them throughout the week.**

- **Encourage someone else by reminding them of their identity in Christ.**

Remember

- **Your identity is found in Christ, not in your past.**
- **God's love is received by grace, not earned through performance.**
- **Spiritual growth flows from knowing who you belong to.**
- **God is continually shaping His people for His purposes.**
- **When we believe God's truth about us, it transforms how we live.**

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Father God,
