Watch for the Signs

Highlighted Scripture

Exodus 3:2–4 (CSB)

“Then the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire within a bush. As Moses looked, he saw that the bush was on fire but was not consumed. So Moses thought, ‘I must go over and look at this remarkable sight. Why isn’t the bush burning up?’

When the Lord saw that he had gone over to look, God called out to him from the bush, ‘Moses, Moses!’

‘Here I am,’ he answered.”

Luke 22:33–34, 55–62 (ESV)

“Peter said to him, ‘Lord, I am ready to go with you both to prison and to death.’

Jesus said, ‘I tell you, Peter, the rooster will not crow this day, until you deny three times that you know me.’”

(Then follows the full account of Peter’s three denials and the rooster crowing, ending with Peter weeping bitterly.)

Matthew 25:35–45 (NIV)

“For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat... Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me... Truly I tell you, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me.”

Discussion Questions

1. Which part of today's message about "missing the signs" resonated with you the most?
2. Can you recall a time when God "redirected" you after you missed a spiritual nudge or direction?
3. Why do you think we often question whether God is really prompting us—"Was that really You, God?"
4. What are some practical ways we can stay more spiritually alert to God's small, subtle signs?
5. In light of Matthew 25, what does it look like to notice and act on God's promptings toward serving others?

Reflection Challenge

This week, ask God to help you recognize one specific prompting from the Holy Spirit—especially one that involves serving, encouraging, or noticing someone who may be struggling.

When you sense that inner nudge, don't second-guess it.

Don't delay.

Don't assume someone else will step in.

Act on it and trust that God is guiding your "spiritual GPS," even when the sign is small or easy to overlook.

Write down at the end of the day whether you noticed any "God signs," and how you responded.

Prayer

Heavenly Father, thank You for never giving up on us, even when we miss Your signs or ignore Your gentle nudges. Help us become more aware of Your guidance and more willing to obey Your promptings. Give us hearts that notice the needs around us and the courage to act when You call. Teach us to hear Your voice clearly and to follow Your direction with humility and faith.
