## **Don't Grow Weary Doing Good**

### **Highlighted Scripture**

**Romans 12:17–21**

**“Repay no one evil for evil, but give thought to do what is honorable in the sight of all.**

**If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all.**

**Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave it to the wrath of God, for it is written, ‘Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord.’**

**To the contrary, if your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink; for by doing so you will heap burning coals on his head.**

**Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.”**

**Galatians 6:9**

**“And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.”**

### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Why is it often harder to respond with kindness when we feel taken advantage of?**

- 2. What does it mean practically to “leave room for God’s justice” instead of seeking revenge?**
- 3. How can doing good protect your heart even when others act unfairly?**
- 4. What are some signs that you may be growing weary in doing good?**
- 5. How can trusting God’s timing help you keep going when you feel burned out?**

## **Reflection Challenge**

**Think about an area in your life where you feel exhausted from doing the right thing.**

**Maybe it’s:**

- **Serving others**
- **Being patient with someone**
- **Continuing to show grace**
- **Carrying responsibilities for your family**

**Instead of focusing on the unfairness, try shifting your focus to faithfulness.**

**Ask yourself:**

- **Am I letting other people’s behavior determine my character?**
- **Am I trusting God to handle what I cannot control?**
- **Am I continuing to do good, even when it feels unnoticed?**

**Remember:**

- ✨ **Doing good is not wasted.**
- ✨ **God sees every act of faithfulness.**
- ✨ **Justice belongs to Him.**
- ✨ **A harvest comes to those who don’t give up.**
