Discussion Questions

- 2. Jeremiah 31:33 says God writes His law on our hearts. What does that look like in your everyday life?**
- 3. How can you intentionally love your neighbor today in a way that goes beyond “following rules”?**

This week, look for one area where you typically act out of duty or habit. Ask God to transform that action into one motivated by love. Write it down — and practice it intentionally at least once.
