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## **A Heart That Stays Close to God**

### **Highlighted Scripture**

- **Psalms 51:10**

**David prays, asking God to create a clean heart within him and renew a steadfast spirit. Rather than focusing on changing his circumstances, David asks God to transform him from the inside out.**

### **Discussion Questions**

- **Shane says the real question is not "Am I doing enough?" but "Where is my heart?" Why is that distinction important?**
- **How can someone remain busy with Christian activities while slowly drifting away from God?**
- **Why did David ask God to change his heart before asking Him to change anything else?**
- **What are some warning signs that your relationship with God has become more routine than relational?**

- **What practical habits help you stay spiritually connected to God throughout the week?**

### **Reflection Challenge**

**Spend less time evaluating your performance and more time examining your heart.**

**Ask yourself:**

- **Am I spending time with God because I love Him or simply because it's part of my routine?**
- **What distractions have slowly pulled my attention away from Him?**
- **Is there an area where I need to invite God to renew my heart?**

**Try this:**

- **Begin each day by praying Psalm 51:10 in your own words.**
- **Spend five uninterrupted minutes simply talking with God instead of rushing through a checklist.**
- **Identify one habit that has caused spiritual drift and intentionally replace it with time spent with the Lord.**
- **Ask God to reveal areas where your heart has become distracted or divided.**

**Remember**

- **God is most concerned with the condition of our hearts.**
- **Spiritual drift usually happens gradually, not all at once.**

- **A relationship with God is more important than simply completing religious routines.**
- **God welcomes us back with grace whenever we draw near to Him.**
- **Lasting spiritual growth begins with a heart surrendered to God.**

**Thank You for loving me even when my heart begins to drift. Search me and reveal anything that is pulling me away from You. Create in me a clean heart and renew a steadfast spirit within me.
