## **Highlighted Scripture**

**Galatians 3:23–27**

**“But before faith came, we were kept in custody under the law, confined for the faith which should afterward be revealed.**

**So that the law has become our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith.**

**But now that faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor.**

**For you are all children of God, through faith in Christ Jesus.**

**For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.”**

## **Discussion Questions**

- 1. What does it mean to be “clothed” in Christ?**
- 2. How does understanding the purpose of the law deepen your appreciation for grace?**
- 3. In what ways should someone who has “put on Christ” look different from before?**
- 4. What does it mean practically to walk as a child of God?**
- 5. How can your life “radiate” Christ to those around you?**

## **Reflection Challenge**

**Imagine putting on a garment each morning.**

**Before you begin your day, pause and intentionally say:**

**“Today I put on Christ.”**

**Ask yourself:**

- **Do my words reflect Him?**
- **Do my reactions reflect Him?**
- **Does my attitude reflect Him?**

**Let your life reflect the One who covers you.**

- ✨ **You are no longer under the law — you are justified by faith.**
- ✨ **You are a child of God.**
- ✨ **You are clothed in Christ.**
- ✨ **Walk like who you already are.**
