Highlighted Scripture

Hebrews 6:17–20 (NIV)

“Because God wanted to make the unchanging nature of his purpose very clear to the heirs of what was promised, he confirmed it with an oath. God did this so that, by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have fled to take hold of the hope offered to us may be greatly encouraged.

We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain, where our forerunner, Jesus, has entered on our behalf. He has become a high priest forever, in the order of Melchizedek.”

Discussion Questions

- 1. Julie shared that the word “anchor” kept coming to her in prayer. What does it mean to you personally to be anchored in Christ during uncertain or difficult seasons?**
- 2. Hebrews describes hope as “an anchor for the soul, firm and secure.” How does this image help you understand God’s role in the middle of life’s storms?**
- 3. The devotional emphasized that storms can take many forms—weather, financial, medical, or family-related. What kind of storm are you currently facing, and how have you been responding to it?**

- 4. Julie reminded us that God does not change, even though our circumstances do. How does God's unchanging nature bring comfort or stability in your life right now?**
- 5. The message encouraged us not to stay focused on the storm, but to run to Jesus with it. What does "running to Him" look like practically for you?**

Reflection Challenge

This week, reflect on the following:

- Am I anchoring my hope in Christ or in changing circumstances?**
- Do I bring my storms to Jesus, or do I try to carry them alone?**
- How can I remind myself daily that God's promises do not change?**

Remember:

- God's promises are unchanging**
- Hope in Christ is firm and secure**
- Jesus is our anchor in every storm**
