Baptism: A New Life in Christ

Highlighted Scripture

- **Romans 6:4**

Believers are buried with Christ through baptism into death so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead, they too may walk in newness of life.

Discussion Questions

- **Rob describes baptism as "an outward sign of an inward change." What does that statement mean to you?**
- **According to Romans 6:4, what does going under the water and coming back out symbolize?**
- **Why is it important to remember that baptism itself does not save us, but points to what Christ has already done?**
- **Rob shares that since his baptism he has become more intentional with his words and actions. How should our new identity in Christ shape our daily lives?**

- **Whether you were baptized as a child or as an adult, how has your understanding of baptism grown over time?**

Reflection Challenge

Reflect on what it means to live the new life Christ has given you.

Ask yourself:

- **Am I living as someone whose old life has been left behind?**
- **Do my words, actions, and attitudes reflect my identity in Christ?**
- **How can I intentionally honor Christ in my daily decisions?**

Try this:

- **Read Romans 6:4 and thank God for the new life you have in Christ.**
- **Share with someone what your baptism means to you personally.**
- **Choose one area of your life where you want your actions to better reflect your commitment to Christ.**
- **Pray that your daily life would consistently point others to Jesus.**

Remember

- **Baptism publicly declares our faith in Jesus Christ.**
- **Baptism symbolizes Christ's death, burial, and resurrection.**
- **Our old life no longer defines who we are in Christ.**

- **Following Jesus is a daily walk, not just a one-time decision.**
- **Our new identity in Christ should be reflected in how we live each day.**
