## **Highlighted Scripture**

**John 3:16–18**

**“For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.**

**God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him.**

**There is no judgment against anyone who believes in him. But anyone who does not believe in him has already been judged for not believing in God’s one and only Son.”**

**“If you love me, obey my commandments.”**

**1 John 4:20**

**“If someone says, ‘I love God,’ but hates a fellow believer, that person is a liar; for if we don’t love people we can see, how can we love God, whom we cannot see?”**

## **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Why is it important to understand that God's love for us does not change?**
- 2. How does knowing God loves you unconditionally affect how you approach your relationship with Him?**
- 3. According to Jesus, how do we demonstrate our love for God?**
- 4. Why do actions reveal the truth about our love more clearly than words?**
- 5. How can loving others become a practical way of loving God?**

## Reflection Challenge

**Spend some time reflecting on the difference between receiving God's love and responding to God's love.**

**God's love for you is secure and unchanging.**

**But your love for Him grows through obedience and the way you live.**

**Ask yourself:**

- Does the way I live reflect that I love God?**
- Are my actions aligning with what I say I believe?**
- Am I showing love to others as a reflection of God's love in me?**

**Remember:**

**✨ God's love for you is perfect and complete.**

**✨ You cannot earn more of it or lose it.**
