## The Love of Jesus

## Highlighted Scripture

**John 15:13–14 (KJV)**

**Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.**

**Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.**

**Hebrews 13:2 (KJV)**

**Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.**

## Discussion Questions

- 1. Jesus said the greatest love is laying down one's life for friends. How does Tony broaden that idea beyond dramatic sacrifice to everyday acts of love?**
- 2. The message emphasizes that sharing the love of Christ doesn't always mean preaching—it can mean meeting a simple need. Why do we sometimes underestimate the power of small acts of kindness?**
- 3. Tony shared examples of engaging with homeless individuals through prayer and conversation. What fears or hesitations might prevent us from stepping into moments like these?**
- 4. Jesus calls us His friends if we obey Him. How does obedience connect to demonstrating Christlike love toward others?**

## 5. Who might God be placing in your path right now—not by accident, but by purpose—for you to reflect the love of Jesus?

### Reflection Challenge

**This week, intentionally look for opportunities to stand in the gap for someone else.**

**Ask yourself daily:**

- **Am I willing to be interrupted for love?**
- **Am I listening for the Holy Spirit's prompting?**
- **How can I reflect Jesus through simple, sincere actions?**

**Remember:**

- ★ **Love is action, not intention**
- ★ **Small acts can carry eternal impact**
- ★ **Jesus meets people through willing hearts**
