Reflection Challenge

Ask yourself:

- **Am I constantly rushing toward the next thing without appreciating today?**
- **How can I become more present with the people God has placed around me?**
- **What blessings or lessons might God be showing me in ordinary moments?**

Try this:

- **Spend intentional time with family or loved ones without**

distractions

- **Take notice of God's creation and daily blessings during your routine**
- **Thank God not only for future promises, but for what He is doing in your life today**

- **Eternity with Christ is our destination, but God also works through the journey**
- **Everyday moments can carry spiritual meaning and growth**
- **God desires abundant life, not merely survival through life**
- **Slowing down can help us recognize God's presence more clearly**
- **Relationships and shared experiences are gifts from God**
