Highlighted Scripture

- **James 4:8**

"Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you." Deanne emphasizes that lasting spiritual growth comes from continually pursuing a close relationship with God.

- **2 Timothy 2:15**

Believers are encouraged to diligently study God's Word so they can rightly understand and faithfully apply the truth.

- **John 14:6**

Jesus declares that He is the way, the truth, and the life, and that no one comes to the Father except through Him.

Discussion Questions

- **Deanne shares that saying the sinner's prayer alone did not produce spiritual growth. What is the difference between making a decision for Christ and becoming a disciple of Christ?**

- **Why is it important to study Scripture for yourself rather than relying only on what others say?**
- **Deanne challenges the common saying, "God won't give you more than you can handle." Why is it important to distinguish between popular sayings and what Scripture actually teaches?**
- **How has God used difficult seasons to deepen your faith and dependence on Him?**
- **What practical steps help you continue growing in your relationship with Christ over the long term?**

Reflection Challenge

Focus on growing deeper in your walk with Christ rather than simply gaining more knowledge.

Ask yourself:

- **Am I intentionally pursuing a deeper relationship with God?**
- **Do I regularly study God's Word to understand what it actually says?**
- **Is there an area where God is calling me to greater obedience or trust?**

Try this:

- **Read one chapter of Scripture each day and ask God to reveal something about His character.**
- **Compare a familiar Christian saying with what the Bible actually teaches.**

- **Spend time thanking God for His faithfulness throughout your spiritual journey.**
- **Ask God to help you become not only a hearer of His Word, but a faithful disciple who lives it out.**

Remember

- **Spiritual growth requires commitment, discipleship, and obedience.**
- **God's Word should always be our foundation for truth.**
- **Difficult seasons often become opportunities to draw nearer to God.**
- **Jesus alone is the way to salvation.**
- **God faithfully continues His work in those who choose to trust Him.**
