Highlighted Scripture

- **Galatians 5:1**

Paul reminds believers that Christ has set them free and encourages them to stand firm rather than returning to spiritual bondage.

- **Galatians 5:13**

Julie emphasizes that Christian freedom is not for self-indulgence but for serving one another humbly in love.

Discussion Questions

- **Julie contrasts the freedom many believers enjoy with those who must practice their faith in secret. How does that perspective affect your appreciation for religious freedom?**

- **According to Galatians 5:13, what is the purpose of the freedom Christ has given us?**

- **Why is serving others one of the greatest expressions of**

Christian freedom?

- **Julie says we can all be "on mission" where we live. What opportunities has God placed in your everyday life to share His love?**
- **How can we encourage believers who may be hesitant or fearful about expressing their faith?**

Reflection Challenge

This week, intentionally use your freedom in Christ to serve someone else.

Ask yourself:

- **Am I using the freedom God has given me to glorify Him or simply for my own comfort?**
- **Who around me may need encouragement in their walk with Christ?**
- **How can I faithfully represent Jesus in my daily interactions?**

Try this:

- **Pray for believers around the world who worship under difficult or dangerous circumstances.**
- **Look for one opportunity this week to encourage someone spiritually.**
- **Thank God for the freedom you have to openly worship and share your faith.**
- **Ask God to show you one person in your everyday routine who needs to experience His love.**

- **Christ has set His people free to live for Him.**
- **Christian freedom is expressed through humble service and love.**
- **Mission work begins wherever God has placed us.**
- **Our everyday interactions provide opportunities to reflect Christ.**
- **The freedom to follow Jesus is a gift that should never be taken for granted.**
