Discussion Questions

- 2. When uncertainty increases, what is your first instinct – control, prayer, avoidance, or action?**
- 3. How do you personally recognize when God is shifting a season in your life?**
- 4. What practical habits help you stay spiritually steady when circumstances feel unstable?**
- 5. In what ways can you model calm confidence in God for others around you?**

Reflection Challenge

Instead of focusing on what feels unclear, focus on what is certain:

- God is present.**
- God is sovereign.**
- God is working.**

Choose one daily action that reflects that confidence – whether it's intentional prayer for leaders, journaling what God is teaching you in this season, or responding calmly in a situation that normally would frustrate you.

Let your stability reflect your trust.

- ✨ You can be steady even when seasons shift.**
- ✨ You can pray instead of react.**
- ✨ You can lead with peace because God leads you.**
