Remembering God's Faithfulness

Highlighted Scripture

• **Romans 8:28**

"And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose."

Even when we cannot immediately understand our circumstances, God is faithfully working through every season to accomplish His good purposes.

Discussion Questions

- **Shane points out that we often understand God's work by looking backward rather than forward. Why do you think that is true?**
- **Can you think of a season in your life that only made sense after enough time had passed?**
- **Why is it difficult to trust God when we cannot yet see what He is doing?**

- **Shane says that God's faithfulness often becomes clearer in hindsight. How does remembering God's past faithfulness strengthen your faith today?**
- **What are some practical ways believers can intentionally remember what God has done in their lives?**

Reflection Challenge

Spend time reflecting on God's faithfulness throughout your life.

Ask yourself:

- **Is there a difficult season that I now recognize God used for my good?**
- **Where have I seen God's hand at work that I didn't recognize at the time?**
- **How can remembering God's past faithfulness help me trust Him with my current circumstances?**

Try this:

- **Write down three situations where God proved faithful, even if you didn't recognize it immediately.**
- **Thank God for one unanswered prayer that, looking back, you now understand differently.**
- **Share one story of God's faithfulness with a family member or friend.**
- **When uncertainty arises this week, remind yourself of one way God has faithfully led you in the past.**

Remember

- **God's work is often understood more clearly in hindsight.**
- **Delayed understanding does not mean God is absent.**
- **Remembering God's past faithfulness strengthens present-day trust.**
- **God is at work even when His plans are not immediately obvious.**
- **Looking back with gratitude helps us move forward with confidence.**

Thank You for Your constant faithfulness, even during seasons when I could not understand what You were doing. Help me remember the ways You have guided, protected, and provided for me throughout my life. When I face uncertainty, remind me that You are still working even when I cannot yet see the outcome.
