The Spirit of Truth

Highlighted Scripture

John 14:6–12

Jesus declares that He is the way, the truth, and the life, and that no one comes to the Father except through Him. He teaches that those who believe in Him will continue His works through God's power.

John 16:5–15

Jesus promises that after His departure, the Holy Spirit—the Spirit of Truth—will come to guide believers, convict the world concerning sin, and glorify Christ by revealing God's truth.

Discussion Questions

- **What does Jesus mean when He says He is “the way, the truth, and the life”?**
- **Why was it important for the Holy Spirit to come after Jesus returned to the Father?**

- **How does the Holy Spirit guide believers into truth today?**
- **What is the relationship between the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in these passages?**
- **How can believers remain spiritually sensitive to the guidance of the Holy Spirit?**

Reflection Challenge

Focus on listening for God's truth and guidance through the Holy Spirit.

Ask yourself:

- **Am I seeking God's direction through prayer and Scripture?**
- **Do I rely more on my own understanding or on God's guidance?**
- **How can I become more attentive to conviction and spiritual wisdom?**

Try this:

- **Spend quiet time each day reading Scripture and praying for discernment**
- **Pause before major decisions and ask God for wisdom**
- **Reflect on moments where God may already be guiding or correcting you**

Remember

- **Jesus is the way to the Father**
- **The Holy Spirit points believers toward truth and toward**

Christ

- **God's Spirit guides, convicts, and comforts His people**
- **Spiritual wisdom comes from staying close to God**
