- 4. How does humility play a role in God's process of restoring and reviving us?**
- 5. When was the last time you truly felt "spiritually alive," and what helped you reach that place?**

Reflection Challenge

This week, make space for personal revival. Choose one area of your life where you feel spiritually dull or disconnected. Set aside time to pray specifically for renewal in that area.

Ask God:

"Lord, revive my heart so that my life reflects Your love."

As you do, look for small ways to act on that revival—serve someone, forgive someone, or share your faith with someone who needs hope.
