Highlighted Scripture

Galatians 2:20 (ESV)

"I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."

Discussion Questions

- 1. What does it mean for you personally to be "crucified with Christ"?**
- 2. How can dying to self daily shape your relationships and actions?**
- 3. Can you think of a time when a small act of kindness reflected Christ to you?**
- 4. In what ways do you struggle with choosing self over Christ, and how can you surrender those areas?**
- 5. Who is one person you could intentionally show Christ's love to today?**

Reflection Challenge

- Reflect on Galatians 2:20 and write it somewhere you can see daily this week.**
- Practice one intentional act of kindness each day to reflect Jesus in you.**

- **Begin each morning by praying, “Lord Jesus, let me reach just one person today with Your love.”**
- **Journal about what it feels like to live “alive in Christ” instead of for yourself.**

“Lord Jesus, let me just reach one today. Let me just speak to one person today, because that one person is in desperate need to hear what You have to tell them. Guide me to the one who needs Your love, and help me live as if You are alive in me. Amen.”
