Made Clean by the Blood of Christ

Highlighted Scripture

- **Ephesians 3:14–21**

Paul prays that believers would be strengthened through the Holy Spirit, rooted and grounded in love, and come to understand the immeasurable love of Christ that surpasses knowledge.

- **Psalms 103:11–12**

Tony references David's declaration that God removes our transgressions "as far as the east is from the west," demonstrating the completeness of His forgiveness.

- **Romans 8:37**

Believers are reminded that through Christ they are "more than conquerors" because of His love and victory.

Discussion Questions

- **Paul prays that believers would understand the depth of Christ's love. Why do you think that can be difficult to fully**

comprehend?

- **Tony compares believers to a diamond ring covered in mud. How does that illustration help you understand God's work of redemption?**
- **Why is it important to see yourself the way God sees you rather than allowing your past to define you?**
- **How does knowing that God has completely forgiven your sins affect the way you live today?**
- **What would change in your daily life if you truly believed you are deeply loved and valued by God?**

Reflection Challenge

Focus on your identity in Christ rather than your past.

Ask yourself:

- **Am I allowing past failures to define how I see myself?**
- **Do I believe God's forgiveness is complete, or do I continue carrying guilt He has already removed?**
- **How does God's love give me confidence to walk faithfully today?**

Try this:

- **Read Ephesians 3:14–21 slowly and thank God for His immeasurable love.**
- **When feelings of guilt or shame arise, remind yourself of Psalm 103:12 and God's complete forgiveness.**

- **Write down three truths Scripture says about your identity in Christ.**
- **Encourage someone this week by reminding them of God's love and the value He places on them.**

Remember

- **God's love is greater than we can fully comprehend.**
- **Through Christ, our identity is no longer defined by our past.**
- **Jesus has completely dealt with our sin through His sacrifice.**
- **God sees His redeemed children as precious and deeply loved.**
- **Our worth is found in Christ, not in our failures.**

Prayer

Father God,

Thank You for loving me more deeply than I can fully understand. Thank You for washing away my sin through the sacrifice of Jesus Christ and giving me a new identity in Him. Help me to see myself as You see me—not through the lens of my past, but through Your grace and redeeming love. Root me firmly in Your love, strengthen my faith, and help me live each day with confidence in who I am in Christ.
