Discussion Questions

- **What common thread do you see in the stories of Joseph, Naomi, Gideon, Peter, Mary Magdalene, and Abraham?**
- **Why do people often feel unqualified or unworthy to be used by God?**
- **How does 1 Peter 2:9 change the way believers should view themselves?**
- **What parts of your story have you struggled to share with others?**
- **How can God use difficult experiences to impact someone**

else's life?

Reflection Challenge

Spend time reflecting on your personal story and how God has worked through it.

Ask yourself:

- **What challenges or hardships has God brought me through?**
- **Where have I seen God's faithfulness in difficult seasons?**
- **Am I hiding parts of my testimony because of fear or shame?**

Try this:

- **Write down key moments where God has worked in your life.**
- **Thank God for ways He has redeemed difficult circumstances.**
- **Share part of your testimony with someone you trust.**
- **Pray for opportunities to encourage others through your story.**

Remember

- **God often chooses imperfect people to accomplish His purposes.**
- **Your past does not disqualify you from being used by God.**
- **God sees your heart more than your qualifications.**
- **Difficult experiences can become powerful testimonies.**

- **You were chosen by God for a purpose.**
