Walking in the Light of Christ

Highlighted Scripture

• **John 8:12–18**

Jesus declares, "I am the light of the world." Those who follow Him will not walk in darkness but will have the light of life. He also affirms that His testimony is true because He has been sent by the Father.

Discussion Questions

- **Jesus says that those who follow Him will not walk in darkness. What does "walking in the light" look like in everyday life?**
- **Tony explains that light reveals truth. Why is it important to allow Christ to expose areas of our lives that need to change?**
- **How does following Jesus help us see situations differently than the world does?**
- **Tony says believers are called to be lights to those walking**

in darkness. What are some practical ways we can do that?

- **Have you experienced a time when God's truth helped you clearly understand a situation that once seemed confusing?**

Reflection Challenge

Intentionally walk in the light of Christ.

Ask yourself:

- **Am I allowing Jesus to guide my decisions, or am I relying on my own understanding?**
- **Is there an area of my life where I need God's light to reveal truth?**
- **How can I reflect Christ's light to someone around me today?**

Try this:

- **Read John 8:12 each morning and ask God to guide your thoughts and actions throughout the day.**
- **Pray for discernment in one area where you need God's wisdom.**
- **Look for an opportunity to encourage someone who may be struggling or discouraged.**
- **At the end of each day, thank God for one way He revealed His truth to you.**

Remember

- **Jesus is the true Light of the world.**
- **Following Christ leads us out of spiritual darkness.**

- **God's truth helps us see life from His perspective.**
- **Believers are called to reflect Christ's light to others.**
- **Walking in the light means continually following Jesus each day.**
