### Highlighted Scripture

### Discussion Questions

- 3. Have there been times in your life when something felt like a setback, but later proved to be God’s protection?**
- 4. Psalm 121 speaks of God watching over our “coming and going.” What does that mean for everyday life?**
- 5. How can sharing your personal testimony help someone else see God’s faithfulness in their own life?**

### Reflection Challenge

**Take time to look back:**

**Where can I clearly see God's protection or provision?**

**What struggles now make more sense in light of where I am today?**

**How has God guided my steps, even when I didn't recognize it at the time?**
